#### <u>Principal's Report – April 2021</u> New Public Health Protocol for Positive Cases

Last week, we were advised that Public Health is now treating all positive cases of COVID-19 as suspected variants. This has a much broader impact than the previous protocol, as we saw with our case last week.

Here are the details of the new protocol:

- All students in the same class and/or in the same daycare group as the positive case are required to isolate for 14 days. Students on the same school bus may or may not also be required to isolate for 14 days, but Public Health will need to perform contact tracing to make that decision.
  - Students who are required to isolate will need to be tested on two separate occasions, according to the dates indicated by Public Health.
  - Their family members must also remain in quarantine until the confirmation of a negative test result. This means that siblings cannot attend school or daycare and parents cannot go to work until the negative result is received.
  - Regardless of the test results, the students who are required to isolate must remain in isolation for the full 14 days.

### April 27 Strike

You should have received an email from the school board regarding an announced strike on Tuesday April 27.

Because of the strike, school will end at approximately 12:55 PM on Tuesday April 27, with school buses departing at 1:05 PM. There will be no after school daycare service on that day. All students who do not take the school bus will need to be picked up at 12:55 PM.

### **Registration News**

One minor change from what was presented in March – due to the number of registrations and the number of coded students going into Grade 2, we will have a 1/2 split after all. Our Resource class ("Room 2") is also confirmed. We will have additional French Resource time compared to this year.

### **Recent Purchases**

Three more steel tables have been ordered to create a second outdoor classroom on the Junior side. A large shed has also been ordered to store playground equipment. Both items are expected in soon.

### **Playground Project**

We received unofficial authorization from the Ministry for our major project. We are currently working with potential suppliers, as we are ready to go to tender.

### **Beehive Update**

Representatives from Alveole came to visit recently. Our behive will be installed on the school roof in early June.
